The facts of the matter have not changed, as this is a repetition of the previous enquiry brought about by a mistake in the order by yourselves

Mrs Anne Childs, further to her telephone conversation with you this morning wishes to object, but was quite correctly informed she would be too late, as her letter although dated 6th November, would not arrive in your office until 8th November.

I should like to mention this for the record, and take the opportunity on objecting on her behalf as a BHS member

I respectfully point out to the Principal Rights of Way Officer, that the obstruction mentioned at the enquiry, and recommended by the Inspector Captain G F Lassett to be removed, has not been removed, and for the purpose of this order should be removed.
