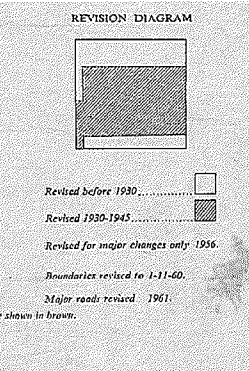
The above Full Reference is unique. For many purposes the first grid letter can be omitted, giving a reference U 812363 which recurs at intervals of 500 Kilometres. If both grid letters are omitted, the resulting reference 812363 recurs at intervals of 100 Kilometres. When the area concerned is sufficiently restricted, as will usually be the case, with maps on scales of one inch to the mile and larger, both the grid letters are normally omitted.

At the Eastern edge of this sheet True North is 0° 57' West of Grid North and at the Western edge 0° 53' West of Grid North.

Magnetic North was about 5° West of Grid North in 1962 decreasing by also 1° in six years. Heights are on feet above Mean Sea Level at Newlyn.

1 square inch on this map represents 17.778 acres on the ground.

Boundaries which have been verified on the ground are shown in black. Boundaries which have not been verified on the ground are shown in brown.
