I am making enquiries on behalf of Tony Barnett as organiser, as to when we might expect a response to the petition with regard to Common Land, which we handed to No. 10 Downing Street on 25th September 2013

No.10 transferred this to DCLG who sent it to DEFRA on 17th October since DCLG say common land is a matter for Defra. However since it is the Planning Inspectorate who are dealing with all the applications on behalf of the Secretary of State, I would say that DCLG need to respond on their behalf as an executive agency of Department for Communities and Local Government, which means that it is a part of DCLG (although has separate budget and management).

These problems appear to cover several management executives, not forgetting Natural England of course, so all should contribute and explain the decisions they are making since it appears that the law is being broken and the authority of Parliament eroded.
