It was agreed that a Session for Registration of Rights for all Commoners should be held next Thursday, 13th June, in the Committee Room of the Lindford Club at 7.30 p.m. sharp.

Mr. R. Beechey, Assistant Solicitor to the Hampshire County Council, has kindly consented to attend and to explain what Registration is all about. Three clerks from the County Commons Registration Dept. will also attend and they will be there to assist Commoners to fill in form C.R.9. and to supply a tracing of the map of your property.

Elderly Past Commoners are specially invited to come along on this occasion to act as an advisory body to the present Commoners many of whom are new to the district. This will possibly give Commoners an opportunity to learn something of the history of their home and its past inhabitants.

If your property was in existence before the 1859 enclosure award and was copyhold of the Manor you will have Rights, though they may not be mentioned in the Deeds. You can also have "Rights of Custom" and the Chairman has a lot of information which will be available on request.

This Session is being organised specially for your benefit and the result of your efforts now could keep Broxhead Common an open space for your successors for ever - so be sure and don't miss this very important meeting on Thursday.
