## Re: Broxhead Common.

As you have probably heard we have now received a copy of the Commissioner's Interim Decision.

We are pleased to say that he has found that Mr. Connell has rights over the whole Common, and Mrs. Cooke over Mr. Whitfield's part of the Common.

So far as the rest of the claims are concerned, however, he has accepted Mr. Whitfield's contention that the evidence of exercise of right was more consistent with a general free for all, than the exercise of specific rights.

As the Commissioner has not in his Decision reviewed the evidence in detail, and also as the Decision itself runs to some fifteen pages, we do not propose to circulate copies, but Mr. Ellis has two copies and we have sent copies to Mr. Connell and Mrs. Cooke, as their claims are dealt with in length.

The case has to come before the Commissioner again for argument as to the exact form of the order, bearing in mind the agreement with the Ministry of Defence and also for argument on costs.
