

Testament of Mr. J. J.

Memorandum on the following Accounts &c. &c.

The Trustees doct. should be drawn up & found in a particular manner for the Inspection of all the Amicable, Explaining to them, All the Receipts and Payments from the commencement of their Trust, & that they may thereby be able to Judge of their several Proportions, Legally due, and coming to them, by virtue of the Deed of Trust, July 9 1776. And Subject to the Wills and Showings there mentioned, as the Trusts may answer.

The Deficiencies upon the Amicities from Midsum. 1777 - to St. Thomas, day 1780 [being one year & Half] Deposited wholly, Upon the Balance Legally arising from the said Receipts & Payments. And to more Money, provided the B. Balance will extend to such payment. Vide the said Family-Deed.
