Mr. Ellis reported that he had met with a representative of the County Council, who was sympathetic to the proposal that some of the old bridleways on Broxhead Common should be re-instated. However, all matters relating to the review of definitive footpaths and bridleways was awaiting the passage of a Bill through Parliament which could have a considerable effect on the laws governing footpaths and bridleways and no action would be taken by the County Council until this matter had been resolved

d. Recreation ground at Heatherlands Estate

Noted that the District Council had been asked if they would be prepared to provide changing facilities for the football pitches, which it was anticipated would be ready for use in the Autumn. The District Council had replied that it was their policy not to provide such facilities for grounds which had a purely local use. However, Mr. Willis stated that he was to meet with Mr. Withey later in the month to discuss the matter
