B. OPEN SPACES (Continued)

ii Standford Green

Estimated cost of repaving and cementing in concrete  
Standford Green was £360-00 plus £54-45 VAT

RESOLVED

that this cost should be included in the Recreation Committee  
proposed budget figure for 1982/83 for presentation to the  
Council for approval.

C. FOOTPATHS AND BRIDLEWAYS

i. Bridleways Nos. 4 and 5 Broxhead Common

Proposals had now been received from the County Council to  
re-route part of bridleways Nos. 4 and 46 on Broxhead Common.  
In view of the fact that members had not yet had time to study  
the proposals on the ground

RESOLVED

that this item be put to the full Council at their meeting on  
10 January 1983.

ii Waymarking

Noted that additional waymarking would be carried out when  
weather conditions improved next Spring.

iii Extinguishment of part of footpath No. 21

At the Council meeting held on 8 November, Mr. Sawyer, Chairman  
of the District Council, had kindly agreed to ask the Rights of  
Way Officer what steps were being taken by him to see that the  
remedial work on this footpath was being carried out. A reply  
was awaited.

iv. Designation of rights of way on Headley Down

Noted that a paper from Judge Lee, the Honorary Legal Adviser  
to the Hampshire Association of Parish Councils concerning  
public rights of way and the new Act, had specifically stated  
that "No new claims can be recorded until this Part" (i.e. Part  
III of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) "comes into force."  
In view of this the matter was not taken up with the Hampshire  
Asscn. of Parish Councils, as resolved at the last Recreation  
Committee meeting, and Miss Balderson, Chairman of the Headley  
Down Ratepayers' Asscn. had been informed of the position, ie  
that all claims must wait until the Regulations are made before  
any action could be taken.

D. Lack of Recreational facilities in the Headley Down/  
Heatherlands area

Mrs. Wadhams stated that there was nothing to report on this item.

E. Headley Down Youth Club

Noted that the October and November grants totalling £16 had been  
paid.

F. Inter Village Sports Competition

Mr. Grevatt reported that he had attended a meeting held at the  
Alton Sports Centre on 30 September which discussed the programme  
for the Junior and Senior Competitions for 1983.  
It had been decided that 26 March should be the date for the  
Junior Competition and 22nd May for the Senior; one or two minor  
amendments had been made to the programme, and following a request  
from Mr. Grevatt, it had been agreed that competitors might use  
the facilities at the Sports Centre, whilst not actually competing.
