581 PROPOSED DIVERSION OF BRIDLEWAYS NOS 4 AND 46

It was noted that the Senior Rights of Way Officer, Hampshire County Council had confirmed that the County Council was asking for the diversion of the southern end of Bridleway No. 4 and the landowner, Mr. Whitfield, was asking for the diversion of part of Bridleway No.46 and the northern end of Bridleway No. 4.

Members considered the proposed diversions and in view of the discrepancies between the routes of the bridleways on the ground, the written description and the definitive map it was

RESOLVED

to inform the County Council that it was considered necessary, in the opinion of the Council, that before any decision could be made the confusing situation ought to be clarified. However, the Parish Council was very much opposed to the diversion of the southern part of Bridleway 1 which would lead to that Bridleway meeting with the B.3004 a more northern point, which would increase the danger to horse riders and road traffic.
