6.01 FOOTPATHS AND BRIDLEWAYS

a. Bridleways on Broxhead Common

Noted that the County Council had decided to divert part of bridleway No. 46 and parts of bridleway No. 4, and the necessary orders would be made after consultations with the service authorities. It was noted with satisfaction that the diversion of the southern end of Bridleway No. 4. was not to be proceeded with.

b. Waymarking

Mr. Williams reported that he had been unable to contact Dr. A. Dunkley, as he was at present on holiday, and, in addition, he felt unable to continue to carry on with the liaison with Dr. Dunkley over waymarking, although he was prepared to continue as the Council's footpaths walker. The Committee Chairman agreed to consult with Dr. Dunkley; Miss Balderson, Mrs. Gamon, Mrs. Rix and Mrs. Wadhams agreed to help with waymarking when this was carried out.

c. Footpath No. 21

Mr. Williams reported that that part of footpath No.21 in the garden of Laurel Cottage had now been restored, but no work had yet been undertaken on the lower part of the path which had been subject to a landslip
