More recently the B3004 is being altered at Sleaford although
there have been many car accidents and one young man killed
at the Coldharbour corner bends.

During the planning stage for the alteration of the B3004
Council agreed to designate that section of the B3004 which was
redundant i.e south of the New Inn, a Bridleway.

As I am sure you realise riding horses is a dangerous pursuit
best of times and riding on roads even our narrow country lanes
were once cart tracks, is suicidal and so a safe place to ride
A325 is desperately needed.

Would you consider the possibility of permitting a track to be
the BW46 on Broxhead Common to cross the A325 opposite the
the B3004 when it is eventually downgraded to a bridleway
I am sure I speak for all who pursue the recreation of riding
in being extremely grateful if you can see your way to help.
