"Statutory Duties are things like paying your vehicle licence, community charge etc. We would soon be in the Clink if we didn't cough up. So should it be any different for Local Authorities, who have STATUTORY DUTIES to maintain rights of way?

Neither does it support the THINK CAMPAIGN which says that speed limits are there for our safety and denote the speed at which it is safe to travel. In fact it makes a nonsense of all speed limits which are on roads three times the width.

"The Urban environment is well endowed with 20mph, and other speed restricting devices, so why don't country people count enough to warrant the same protection?
